School Hours for 2019 including the First Week of Term (Week 1)

Punctuality is a discipline and a mark of respect. As a school, we inculcate this habit of being punctual every morning so that the boys are better prepared for a day of learning in school. Please ensure that your child gets sufficient sleep every night and reaches school before 7.30am. Boys are expected to be at their respective assembly points by 7.30am every morning. Please refer to the information below for where your son is to assemble. Dismissal every day is at 1.30pm. CCAs, Remedial and Enrichment Lessons will begin on Week 4 of Term 1 (28 Jan 2019). More information to the boys concerned will be sent out in due course.

Note for P1 Parents on Dismissal and Recess:

For the first week of term (2 January to 4 January), your son will be escorted from class to the Foyer at 1pm every day. This will allow us to settle the P1 boys who go on the school bus first before the rest of the boys are dismissed. Parents who are picking up their P1 sons and not going on the school bus are to approach their son's Form Teacher in the Foyer. The Form Teacher will then release your son and you may leave the Campus before the official time of 1.30pm.

P1 parents may 'observe' their son from a distance in the canteen during Recess (all other areas are out of bounds) which begins at 9.00am for the P1 boys on Wednesday 2 January. They may do this only for the first day of school. Rest assured, they will be well taken care of by our Parent Shepherds for the first two days of school, and then subsequently by the P4 buddies.

A gentle reminder to prepare a healthy snack for your P1 son for his 'elevenses' in addition to what you would like him to have for his Recess. This is to tide him over till school dismissal as his Recess is early at 9.30am.

Assembly Point on First Day of School

All P1 boys are to report to the Speech & Drama Room / Music Room on Wednesday 2 January and for the rest of the week between 7am and 7.30am. Parents are allowed to escort their sons there. Our Form Teachers will be waiting to welcome your son.

All P2-P6 boys are to report to their respective classrooms for Wednesday 2 January. Please allow your son to walk to their classrooms unescorted. The Teaching Block continues to remain out of bounds to all parents and other unofficial visitors to the School. The boys will also report to their classroom on Thursday 3 January the MPH on Friday 4 January.

What to Bring on the First Day of School

All P1-P6 boys are to bring only their pencil case, colouring pencils, a story book and a water bottle. **They are not to bring any school books.** Boys will be advised by their respective Form and Subject Teachers when they are to bring their books. Formal academic lessons will begin on 7 January after the orientation week. Please also ensure that all your son/ward's belongings are properly labelled. P1 boys are to have their lanyards with them for the first two weeks of school.

Attire

Boys are to wear their official school uniform when they report to school on Wednesday 2 January. The new corporate t-shirt (which will be sold from February 2019) may be worn on Fridays (except during examinations) and during excursions/camps throughout the year. During the next 2 years of transition (i.e. 2019-2020), we will still allow our students to wear their current Red Corporate T-shirts and White Corporate Polo Shirts. P1 students may also wear their PE uniform during their PAL lessons. White corporate t-shirt and shorts may be worn on Fridays (except during national examinations) and the red corporate t-shirt during excursions throughout the year.

Temperature Taking on Monday 7 Jan & Bringing Thermometers

This is the MOE designated day for conducting a temperature taking exercise. All P2- P6 boys are to bring a working thermometer to school from Wednesday 2 January for the week. All P1 boys will be issued with a thermometer by their Form Teacher prior to the exercise.

Pupil Companion

The Pupil Companion will be given to all boys on 3 January. Your son will be encouraged to write details of his homework in it. You may also wish to use it to communicate with your son's teachers.

Important reminders for Applications for Access Arrangements (AAs)

This is for students with learning or physical disabilities requesting for access arrangements during our internal examinations, based on their individual needs. Please note that all students with a new diagnosis will have to apply for access arrangements such as extra time for their internal examinations as access arrangements are granted on a needs basis in consultation with the teachers and observations during class and exams.

Please also note that the deadline for all applications for access arrangements need to reach us at least 3 weeks before each CA or SA for us to process your application.

1. The closing date for new applications for 2019 PSLE AAs is **17 January 2019**.
2. The closing date for new applications for P4 SA1 & P5 SA1 and CA2 is **8 April 2019**.
3. The opening date for applications for 2020 PSLE AAs is **6 May 2019**.

4. The closing date for new applications for P3 to P5 SA2 as well as the closing date for the 2020 PSLE AAs is **2 September 2019**.

Back to School Safety

Student safety is a priority of the School. The safety of students using roads leading to and from the school is the responsibility of all. We need motorists to play their part by slowing down as they approach the vicinity of the school, and parents to reinforce the importance of road safety at home.

I would like to remind you again:

Students and parents/guardians walking to the School are to use the appropriate traffic light and zebra crossings and to enter the School via Gate Number 3. Please **do not** walk across the Parade Square as vehicles will be moving in and out of the School.

During peak traffic periods such as arrival and dismissal times, students arriving to school by car are to alight at the lay-by along Winstedt Road or the drop-off zone in front of the Foyer/PAH. Our staff and security guards will be deployed to facilitate the flow of traffic and reinforce road safety behaviour. Please cooperate with them.

If you are parking and walking into the Campus to meet or pick up your son/charges, please park at Newton Carpark (as parking is not available during arrival and dismissal times). Please note that vehicles **must not park or wait along Monk's Hill Road, Winstedt Road and Clemenceau Avenue North** as this will cause obstruction to the flow of traffic and inconvenience to the residents nearby. Traffic Police have been called in the past by irate residents and summons have been issued.

Discipline and Safety

Please be reminded that Parents are not to engage directly with other students especially concerning issues with discipline and behaviour. Should there be any matters of concern, please bring this to the attention of our staff for investigation and resolution. Also note, for the safety of our students, boys are not allowed to leave school during lunch break unless they are supervised by their parents/guardian.

Security Passes

For the safety of the students, the school has a Security Pass System to monitor and manage the movement of visitors on Campus. Parents/Care-givers are to display their security pass at all times when on Campus.

An Application Form is available at the General Office. Kindly note that each Security Pass allows for 2 family members'/care-givers' particulars.

Individual Student Details Report (P1 to P6)

Your son/ward will receive an information form (Individual Student Details Report) for your verification from his Form/Co-Form Teacher on Wednesday 2 January. Please assist us by completing the form and ensuring that the contact details as well as medical information is updated. Please do ensure that there are two points of contact in the event of an emergency. Also, please attach at the top right hand corner a recent passport photograph of your son/ward.

Kindly return this document to your son's/ward's Form/Co-Form Teacher by Monday 7 January. If there are any amendments, please make the changes in ink (any colour). Medical information declared will be copied over for subsequent years in the Student Medical Record Module. You may provide supporting medical information (if any) from your son's/ward's attending doctor at a later stage to his Form/Co-Form Teacher if it is presently unavailable.

Teaching Blocks Out of Bounds

This is a reminder that the 3 teaching blocks as well as the corridors linking them are strictly out-of-bounds to non-staff. Parents/care-givers are to remain in the Foyer when dropping off or picking up boys from school. Parents/guardians are allowed to enter the school and meet their children at the foyer from 1.15pm at dismissal time.

Methodist Walk Fundraising 2019

All boys will be given the Methodist Walk Fundraising card on Friday 11 January. They will be encouraged to do their part to support the school's fundraising efforts.
