### **1. PERI Upgrading Updates**

We first communicated this matter to all parents in the beginning of 2019 at the Meet-the-Parents/Breakfast sessions. After the preliminary works by the school, MOE and the consultants, I am pleased to inform you that Sunray Woodcraft Construction Pte Ltd will be the main contractor for the upgrading works. Phase One of the PERI Upgrading Project will commence on 7 September 2019. The initiation phase of this project will consist of renovating the CD shelter to build the Student Care Centre as well as constructing a Ramp for Fire Engine Access area leading to the playground and to the site office (please refer to the attached diagram for the location of these areas).

The hoarding will be put up during the September break and a safety briefing will be given to the school population during assembly on the first day of Term 4. Throughout this project, safety is our priority and the students are to keep clear of the construction area at all times.

For those who are driving, you are advised to avoid parking at Monk's Hill Road during the PERI Upgrading period as Heavy Vehicles will be entering/ exiting through that road.

### **2. Personal Data Protection Policy's NRIC Advisory Guidelines**

With the enforcement of PDPC's NRIC Advisory Guidelines from 1 September 2019, the request for the physical NRIC/equivalent form of ID document to verify the identity of visitors to our school for emergency and security purposes is still required. However, the physical NRIC/ID document will be returned to visitors after verification of identity and not retained by the school.

#### 4. Children's Day Celebration

To celebrate Children's Day, the boys will be having a full day of celebration on 3 October 2019 with various level activities planned for them. Under the 'All for Sports' initiative, Primary 1, 2, 3 and 5 pupils will be having their sports level events. Primary 4 and Primary 6 pupils will have special activities planned for them as well. Primary 1 to Primary 5 boys are required to report to school in PE attire while Primary 6 pupils will report in school corporate shirt. School dismissal is as usual at 1.30pm.

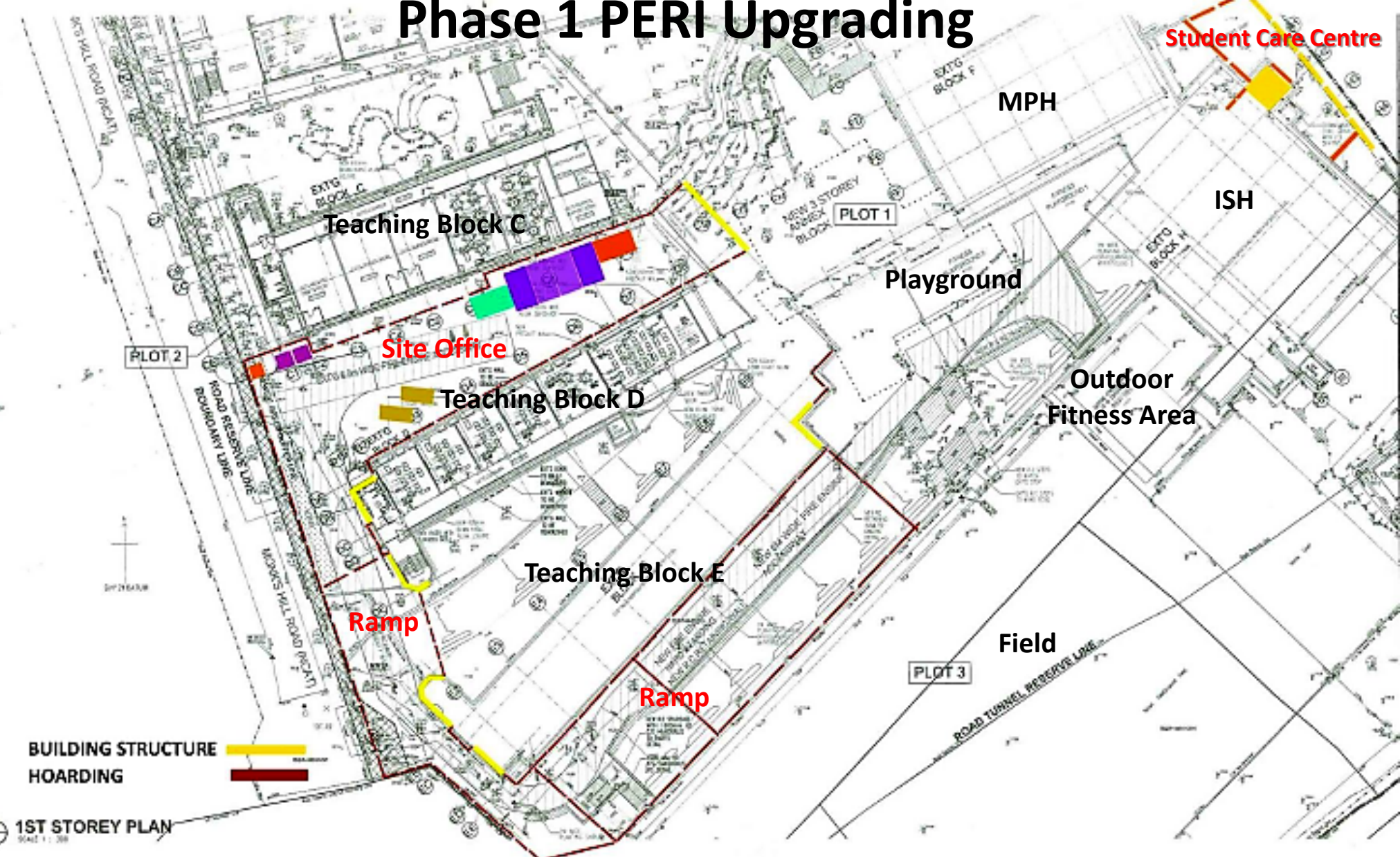
