



RULES AND REGULATIONS

General Rules

- 1) This competition is open to all **P3 to P6 pupils** from ACS (J). JSS is **singing/rapping competition**. Dance and instrumental accompaniment are optional. Judging will be based on the quality of singing.
- 2) Language Medium for all performances: English, Malay, Tamil, Chinese
- 3) Contestants can take part in ONE category only A) SOLO OR B) GROUP (2 to 5)
- 4) Contestants will be allotted up to FIVE (5) MINUTES to perform. There will be a penalty if the time is exceeded.
- 5) Contestants are to provide the performance details for example category, song title, duration upon registration. The Organising Committee reserves the right to reject it if deemed unsuitable for the competition.
- 6) Use of songs containing vulgar, sexually explicit, satanic/black metal or violent language and/or lyrics are strictly prohibited. Participants are not allowed to make alterations to the original song to eliminate the inappropriate content. Such submissions will be disqualified automatically and without notification to the participant.
- 7) NO pyrotechnics, open flames or any other dangerous additions. Contestants are required to notify the organiser in advance if their acts involve dangerous stunts -- i.e. aerial arts or acrobatics.

Audition Instructions

- 1) Pupils who are interested to participate in JSS need to submit their registration forms online and an unedited video on the song they choose to present **by 14 October 2016**.

2) The Finals will be **9 November 2016**.

3) Finalists will be notified by **28 October 2016**.

4) The videos can be submitted through provision of a YouTube link or a USB at the reception by the deadline of 14 October 2016. No late submission will be entertained.

JSS Finals on ACSpress (9 November 2016)

- 1) Once chosen as Finalists, the song choice is final and no changes are allowed. Songs presented on the audition video will be the one to be sung at the finals.
- 2) Finalists must provide their own recorded music (minus 1- karaoke/music only version), instruments, props, etc., if needed. Recorded music **MUST** be on a CD or USB flash drive in an acceptable format (i.e. MP3 or WAV file) one week before 9 November for sound testing.
- 3) All contestants are to dress appropriately during all rounds. Indecent exposure is **NOT** allowed.
- 4) The Judges' decisions on the results are Final. No correspondence or appeal shall be entertained.
- 5) All contestants agree and automatically grant permission to the Organising Committee on the usage of their photographs and/or videos taken as well as printing of their names for advertising, promotional and publicity purposes.
- 6) By submitting personal information for registration, all contestants acknowledge that they have read through the competition Rules & Regulations and consent to allow the Organising Committee to use all personal information for administrative purposes and data analysis. All personal data provided will be kept confidential at all times.
- 7) The Organiser shall not be held liable for any losses, damages or injuries howsoever suffered or caused to any contestant at any stage of the competition.
- 8) The Organising Committee reserves the right to change any of the rules and regulations without prior notice.
- 9) The Organising Committee reserves the right to disqualify any contestant who:
 - (i) brings disrepute to the competition and
 - (ii) does not adhere to any of the above rules and regulations.
