ACSJ Name Tag FAQs

Question 1: Why implement Name Tags?

Answer 1: Name tags support our effort to foster deeper relationships between teacher and students and among the boys. The name tags will enable our boys to have a visible identity and for each boy to be addressed by his name instead of being a nameless statistic or just another face in the crowd.

Question 2: Is the name tag part of the official school uniform?

Answer 2: Yes. Name tags are to be sewn on the white shirts (official school uniform). School corporate t-shirts and PE tank tops do not require name tags.

Question 3: May I use the name tag on the school corporate t-shirt and PE tank top?

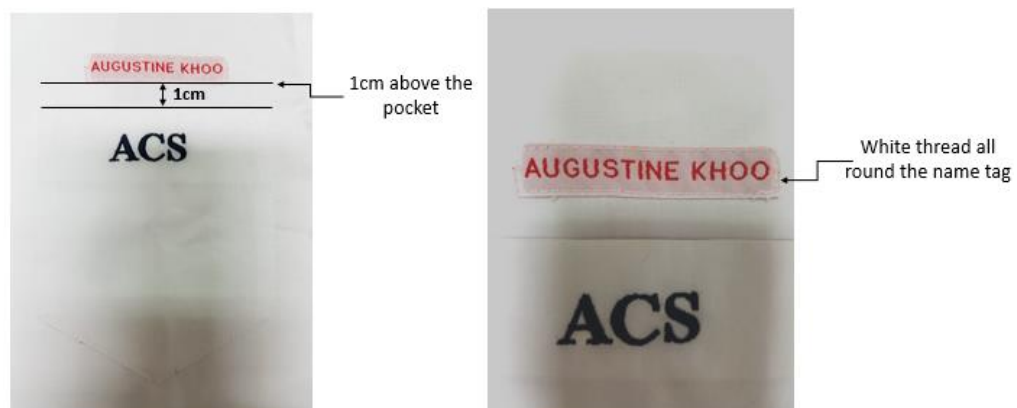
Answer 3: It is not a requirement but if it is used, it should be sewn neatly on the underside of the school corporate t-shirt or PE tank top.

Question 4: Do names have to follow what is indicated in the Birth Certificate?

Answer 4: Names should be printed (as in the Birth Certificate) clearly in BLOCK LETTERS. The name tag has space for 24 characters only, including spaces and punctuation. For Example: Tan Kok Chuan, Edward (name as in BC) may be either TAN KOK CHUAN, EDWARD, TAN KOK CHUAN EDWARD, TAN KOK CHUAN OR EDWARD TAN

Question 5: How should the name tags be sewn on?

Answer 5: Name tags must be sewn with white tread neatly around the edges and affixed 1-cm above the pocket.



Question 6: May I use Velcro strips for the name tags instead of sewing them on?

Answer 6: Yes, you may do so. The Velcro strips attached to the name tag must be sewn with white tread neatly around the edges of the name tag and it must be affixed 1-cm above the pocket.

Question 7: Do we have to change name tag colours every year?

Answer 7: No, you do not have to. The colours assigned/used when the student enters P1 will be used all throughout his 6 years in ACSJ.

Question 8: What is the minimum quantity of name tags I have to purchase?

Answer 8: The minimum order quantity for P5-P6 (2018) and P1-P4 (2018) is 6 pieces and 12 pieces respectively. This should be sufficient for all uniform changes since the colours assigned/used will follow the student throughout his years in ACSJ (Refer to Question 7).

Question 9: I have reservations about security and safety for the boys. Wouldn't our boys become easy target for ill-willed parties in being able to identify their potential prey outside school?

Answer 9: Outside of school, students may use their PE tank tops, school corporate t-shirts or home clothes. Alternatively, you may wish to use Velcro strips (Refer to Question 6). We will continue to emphasise safety and educate students about strangers and suspicious behaviours during assembly talks and in Form Teacher Guidance Periods (FTGP).

Question 10: What about students on financial assistance?

Answer 10: The school will identify students on financial assistance and provide the name tags (including the sewing of name tags) to them without any cost.

Question 11: May I volunteer to help others with the sewing of name tags?

Answer 11: Yes, this is most welcome. Please contact the General Office.

Question 12: I need help with the sewing of name tags. Will the school be able to support me?

Answer 12: We support those on financial assistance (Refer to Question 10) and will only be able to connect you to parent volunteers if they are available (Refer to Question 11).
